#### SERVICES OFFERED

#### In our clinic

- Sick Call Monday-Friday 0710-0810
  - For concerns that must be addressed within 24h, otherwise by appointment
- Dental Hygiene (Cleanings)
  - No hygienist at this time, department is working to hire
  - Wait list available
- General Dentistry
  - Readiness exams
  - Restorations (fillings)
  - Crowns for back teeth

Limited other services by referral to sister clinics

#### SERVICE AVAILABILITY BY HPCON

#### **HPCON-A**

- Resume normal dental services
- Some complex services will depend on sister clinic posture

#### **HPCON-B**

- Suspend aerosol producing procedures (including hygiene)
- Perform only readiness exams and emergent care.
- Stabilize patients in complex treatment
- Some complex services will depend on sister clinic posture

#### HPCON-C

Emergent dental care only, adjustable to local guidance

#### **HPCON-D**

By commanding officer direction
